## SHARK-A-THON July 1st

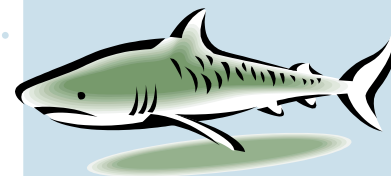
**COACHES CORNER:** Tuesday's Meet against Springdale is very important because it gives us a preview of what Championships will be like!

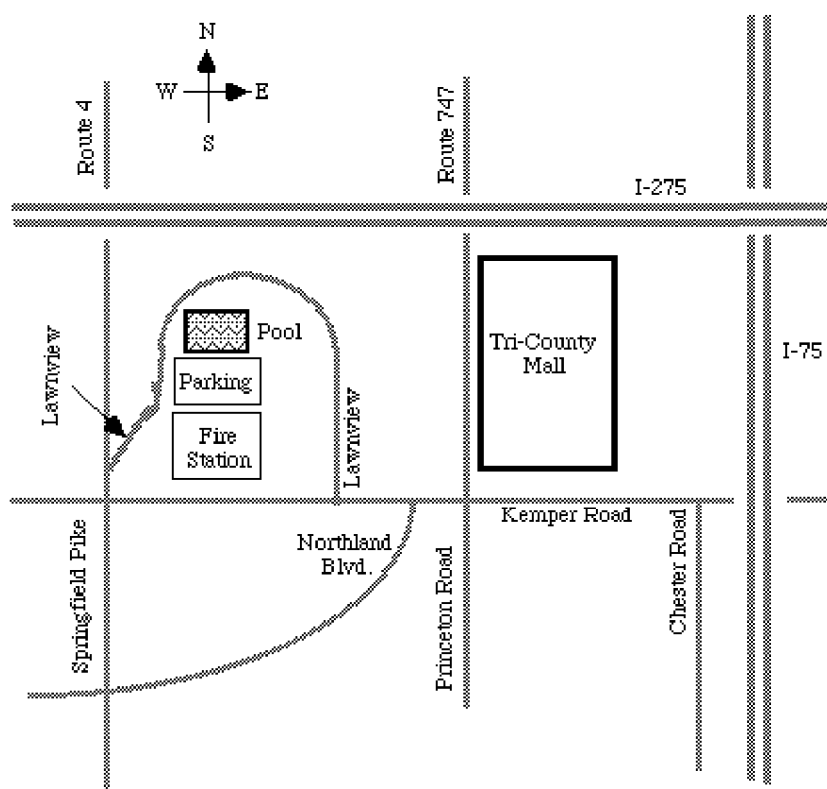
